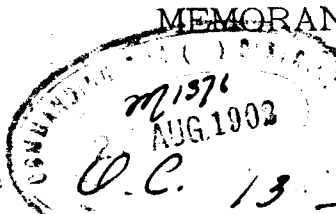

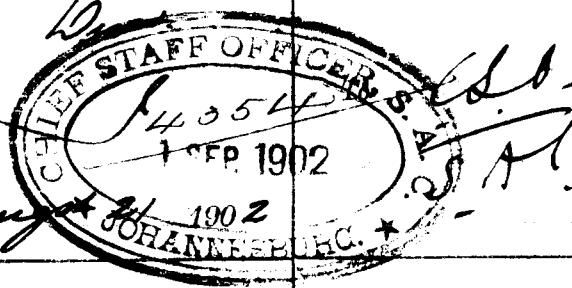

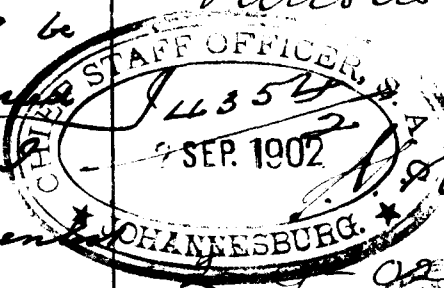
With reference to the

Banded Allowance, so up  
till the time I attached  
them men I had  
received not intimation  
that they could not be  
placed upon the Mounted  
Establishment or that I  
was not allowed to enter  
married men.  
They are not willing to  
serve at 5/- per day.  
In the discharge be carried

mis-informed. It however  
cannot be helped & I now  
recommend that their discharge  
- free - is granted
