If claim is made in respect of damage to, or loss of, movable property, a sworn inventory in detail, showing fair and reasonable values, must be attached.

-) If Commandeering Notes are held, these must be attached in original.
- (C) If any Commandeered or Looted Property has been recovered by you, statement in detail showing values must be submitted.
- (D) If claim is made in respect of Immovable Property, a sworn statement of the damage done, with fair and reasonable estimate of loss, must be attached.
- (E) Agents presenting claims on behalf of absent clients must attach a copy of the Power of Attorney authorising their action.

Any person who submits a claim which is proved on investigation to be excessive, or is found to contain or be supported by any false or misleading statement, is liable to forfeit his right to consideration.
